To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today children learned that God's holiness makes Him perfect, and it is His greatest attribute. God's holiness allowed Jesus to die on the cross for us. We too can be made holy in God's eyes by accepting Jesus sacrifice as the payment for our sins, asking for forgiveness, reverently fearing God, and obeying His commands. Everything God does is motivated by His holiness. (Scripture used: Deuteronomy 32:4, Leviticus 20:8, Psalm 34:9, Psalm 111:9, and Isaiah 5:16)

Memory Work:



"He is the Rock, his works are perfect, and all his ways are just. A faithful God who does no wrong, upright and just is he." Deuteronomy 32:4 NIV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help him or her remember the verse, but it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Draw or color a picture of a "perfect" day. As you work alongside your child, discuss how every person has a different idea about a perfect day, but God's standard of perfection (His holiness) is the true standard. This simple activity will help your child understand that human opinions of perfection are only a small reflection of God's truly perfect holiness.

Help us trust your holiness, God, when we don't understand your ways. We know that you love us because you sent your son, Jesus, to die for us. Please help us remember that only you are perfect, and we can live completely reliant on your word. Amen.
