To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What we learned:

After completing today's lesson, the children better understand the use of the word fear in the Bible as it relates to respecting and honoring God. God doesn't want us to be terrified of Him, but we should respect and honor Him. (Scripture used: Psalm 22:23, 1 Samuel 23:26)



Memory Work:

“For I am a great king,’ says the LORD Almighty, ‘and my name is to be feared among the nations.’” Malachi 1:14 NIV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help him or her remember the verse, but it will also help reinforce what he or she learned during class. Discuss how the nations of the world should respect and honor God.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Together with your child make a list of people that that you respect; this list could include police officers, fire fighters, pastors, mothers, fathers, teachers, bosses, government leaders, etc. Next to the names you listed, write why you respect these people.

Next, ask your child to help you create a list of reasons that we should respect and honor God, as God is by far more deserving of our respect and honor than any of the people contained on the first list.
