To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today children learned that God has shown His great love for us by sending Jesus to die for our sins, choosing us as His servants, giving us the Holy Spirit, and plainly revealing Himself through creation. God's love provides reconciliation for our sins through Jesus Christ. It is His love that upholds the, and it is His love that upholds the patient desire for all people to know Him. (Scriptures used: 1 John 4:9, Ephesians 1:4-6, Romans 5:5, Romans 1:20)

Memory Work:

"According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:" Ephesians 1:4a KJV



Write one to two words of the verse at a time on separate sheets of paper. Read the scripture aloud with your child as you put the papers in order. Then shuffle the papers and help your child put them back in the right order. Read the verse aloud again and repeat the process, this time allowing your child to put them in the correct order (you may read the words for him or her if necessary). Next, start removing papers one at a time to see if your child can say the correct words to the verse. Practice these steps several times this week to help your child remember the verse and reinforce what he or she learned about God during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Draw a picture of Heaven with your child. Be sure to include things like God's throne, angels, and people worshipping God. As you work with your child, discuss how God's love provides the way for us to spend an eternity with Him in Heaven. Explain that not everyone will be in Heaven – only those who believe in Jesus Christ will be with Him forever. Allow time for your child to ask any questions he or she may have about salvation or God's love and explore the answers together in the Bible.



Daily Prayer:

God, You have provided us with an abundance of evidence of Your love for us. Please remind us to share Your love with others so they may have a relationship with You. We want our obedience to be a reflection of Your love. Amen.
