To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, we learned that God wants to communicate with us and how important it is for us to listen. We discovered how God spoke to Moses through a burning bush. We may not hear His voice aloud, but He does speak to our hearts through the Holy Spirit all the time. Sometimes, however, we are just too busy to listen. We need to take time to pray and listen to what God has to say. (Scripture used: Exodus 3:1-15)

Memory Verse:



"My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth." Psalm 121:2 KJV

Practice this verse again with your child during the week. This will not only help them remember the verse but it will also help to reinforce what they learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



This week, start a prayer journal with your child. Have your child write down several prayer requests with enough space below to write how God answers each one. Pray for each request on the list, and add to the journal whenever there is a new request. After a week, discuss the different ways God answers prayers. Explain how prayer is one way we can communicate with God, especially when we are simply silent for a while as we listen for His soft gentle voice.

Daily Prayer:
